


9 ways you can help pollinators

1. **Plant native flowering plants** to give pollinators the food they need to survive.
2. **Avoid pesticides.** Instead, try eco-friendly products that keep pollinators safe.
3. Choose **sustainably produced foods** and support **pollinator-friendly farms** as much as you can.
4. **Be a community scientist!** Use nature apps to document plants and pollinators around you.
5. Don't fear pollinators. Leave them alone and **give them the space they need** to pollinate plants.
6. **Leave your leaves!** Keep decaying vegetation around your home to give pollinators a home, too.
7. **Mow your lawn less frequently** to give pollinators more food and shelter.
8. Give native bees a cozy home in which to live in by **placing a pollinator box** in your garden.
9. **Spread the word** about the importance of pollinators and how we can help them!
